- 3. Solar Panels due to changes in regulations no suitable public buildings other than the Town Hall and Football Club have been found for the installation of the solar panels. It was agreed in principal that alternative uses should be sought with a view to sale at a price to be determined by Members.

The 'Plug-In' Revolution Teignbridge District Council is looking at practical ways to support local residents, businesses and visitors to the area who wish to use Electric Vehicles or other Ultra Low Emission Vehicles and would like to hear your views having looked at the six pledges for action in their new policy at: www.teignbridge.gov.uk/pluginrevolution and by emailing: envc@teignbridge.gov.uk by Friday 18th October 2019. The Town Council noted that there are no charging points along the A38 corridor between Lee Mill Tesco and Dartington and will be asking Teignbridge to look at installing at least two points in Woodholme car park.
